

Federal Jr. Duck Stamp Art Competition

This program is a dynamic, active, art & science program designed to teach wetlands habitat and waterfowl conservation to students in grades K-12. The first place design from the national contest is reproduced on a Junior Duck Stamp for the following year. Junior Duck Stamps are sold by the U.S. Postal Service and Amplex Corporation consignees for \$5 per stamp. Proceeds from the sale of Junior Duck Stamp support conservation education, and provide awards and scholarships for the students, teachers, and schools that participate in the program.
